Mr. Baldacci served as the 73rd Governor of the State of Maine from 2003 until 2011 and currently serves as a member of the board of directors Jobs for America's Graduates, a national nonprofit organization that works to reduce barriers to high school graduation and help students to transition to college.

Mr. Baldacci earned a Bachelor of Science Degree in History from the University of Maine at Orono.

Noteworthy experience in the energy sector

During Mr. Baldacci's second term as the Governor of the State of Maine, he set forth a major effort to promote alternative energies and energy independence for the State of Maine. His programs promoted wind, solar, biofuels and wave technologies. He also started the Energy Efficiency Trust and created new standards and goals for the state's Renewable Portfolio Standards that encouraged alternative energy suppliers to invest in Maine using the State's natural resources sustainably. He also brought the regions leaders together for a special conference to coordinate and corporate on regional energy efforts such as the infrastructure needed to carry the electricity to markets.

Mr. Baldacci previously served as Senior Advisor, Economic Development & Government Relation at the Pierce Atwood LLP from 2012 until May 2021, as director of the U.S. Department of Defense's Military Health Care Reform Initiative from 2011 to 2012, and as U.S. Representatives for Maine's 2nd Congressional District from 1995 to 2003.
