#### Other current professional activities and positions

Mr. Rodriguez is Vice President, General Counsel and Secretary of Avangrid Renewables, LLC, where he supports the renewables businesses. Prior to holding this position, he was Deputy General Counsel at Avangrid Networks and General Counsel at UIL Holdings Corporation where he supported Avangrid Networks' businesses in Connecticut and Massachusetts.

Mr. Rodriguez received his B.A. from Assumption College in Worcester, MA, and his Juris Doctorate from the University of Connecticut Law School. He has attended various leadership training seminars at both Avangrid and Eversource Energy (his former employer), including completing the 2-year Northeast Utilities Finance Academy program. When Mr. Rodriguez joined UIL in 2013, he was responsible for the SEC disclosure and corporate finance matters for the companies and was part of the UIL team for the acquisition of UIL by Iberdrola USA (now Avangrid). Mr. Rodriguez was appointed to his current position in 2022.

Mr. Rodriguez has been an elected Delegate to the Connecticut Bar Association since 2018 and is a member of the Boards of Directors of the United Way of Greater New Haven, Inc.
