DEER RIVER Wind Farm

Project Location: Towns of Harrisburg and Pinckney, Lewis County, New York

Project Status: Development Phase

Number of Wind Turbines: Up to 27 turbines

Households Served: The Deer River Wind Farm is expected to produce enough clean, homegrown electricity to power nearly 25,000 average New York homes annually.

Local Economic Benefits:

Approximately three permanent, full-time jobs

Approximately 125 part-time/temporary jobs during construction

More than \$500,000 annually in landowner lease, easement, and good neighbor payments (\$15 million over 30 years).

The project would likely make payments in the amount of \$800,000 annually in payments to the local towns, counties and school districts (\$24 million over 30 years).

The project would likely spend \$3 million locally on goods & services during development and construction. During development the work will include engineering, geotechnical services, equipment and supplies, surveying, environmental studies, mapping, and permitting. During construction, the work would include work on electrical lines and poles, building construction, logging, concrete, hauling, and civil construction.



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
