

MAD RIVER Wind Farm

Project Location: Town of Worth (Jefferson County) and Town of Redfield (Oswego County)

Project Status: Early-stage development

Number of Wind Turbines: Up to 125

Households Served: The Mad River Wind Farm is expected to produce enough clean, homegrown electricity to power nearly 60,000 average New York homes annually.

Local Economic Benefits:

Approximately 20 permanent, full-time jobs

Approximately 350 part-time/temporary jobs during construction

We anticipate the project would provide payments in the amount of \$2 million annually to the local towns, counties and school districts (\$60 million over 30 years).

The project would likely spend \$9 million locally on goods & services during development and construction. During development the work will include engineering, geotechnical services, equipment and supplies, surveying, environmental studies, mapping, and permitting. During construction the work would include work on electrical lines and poles, building construction, logging, concrete, hauling, and civil construction.
