- Generate 50% of NY’s energy from renewable sources by 2030.
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions 80% by 2050.
- Make energy more affordable for all New Yorkers
- Support the growth of clean energy innovation.
- Create new jobs and business opportunities.
- Protect New York’s natural resources.



Article 10 Review Process

As a major generating facility this project will be subject to the NYS Article 10 power plant siting review process, administered by the NYS Department of Public Service/NYS Public Service Commission). The Article Review process requires consultation with state and local agencies and stakeholders to consider all aspects of the project’s design and potential effects on the environment and local community.
