NORTH RIDGE Wind Farm

Project Location: Towns of Hopkinton & Parishville, St. Lawrence County, New York

Households Served: The North Ridge Wind Farm is expected to produce enough clean, homegrown electricity to power nearly 25,000 average New York homes annually.



Local Economic Benefits:

Approximately six permanent, full-time jobs

Approximately 125 part-time/temporary jobs during construction

More than \$500,000 annually in landowner lease, easement, and good neighbor payments (\$15 million over 30 years).

We anticipate the project would provide payments in the amount of \$750,000 annually to the local towns, county and school district (\$23 million over 30 years).

The project would likely spend \$3 million locally on goods & services during development and construction. During development the work will include engineering, geotechnical services, equipment and supplies, surveying, environmental studies, mapping, and permitting. During construction the work would include work on electrical lines and poles, building construction, logging, concrete, hauling, and civil construction.
