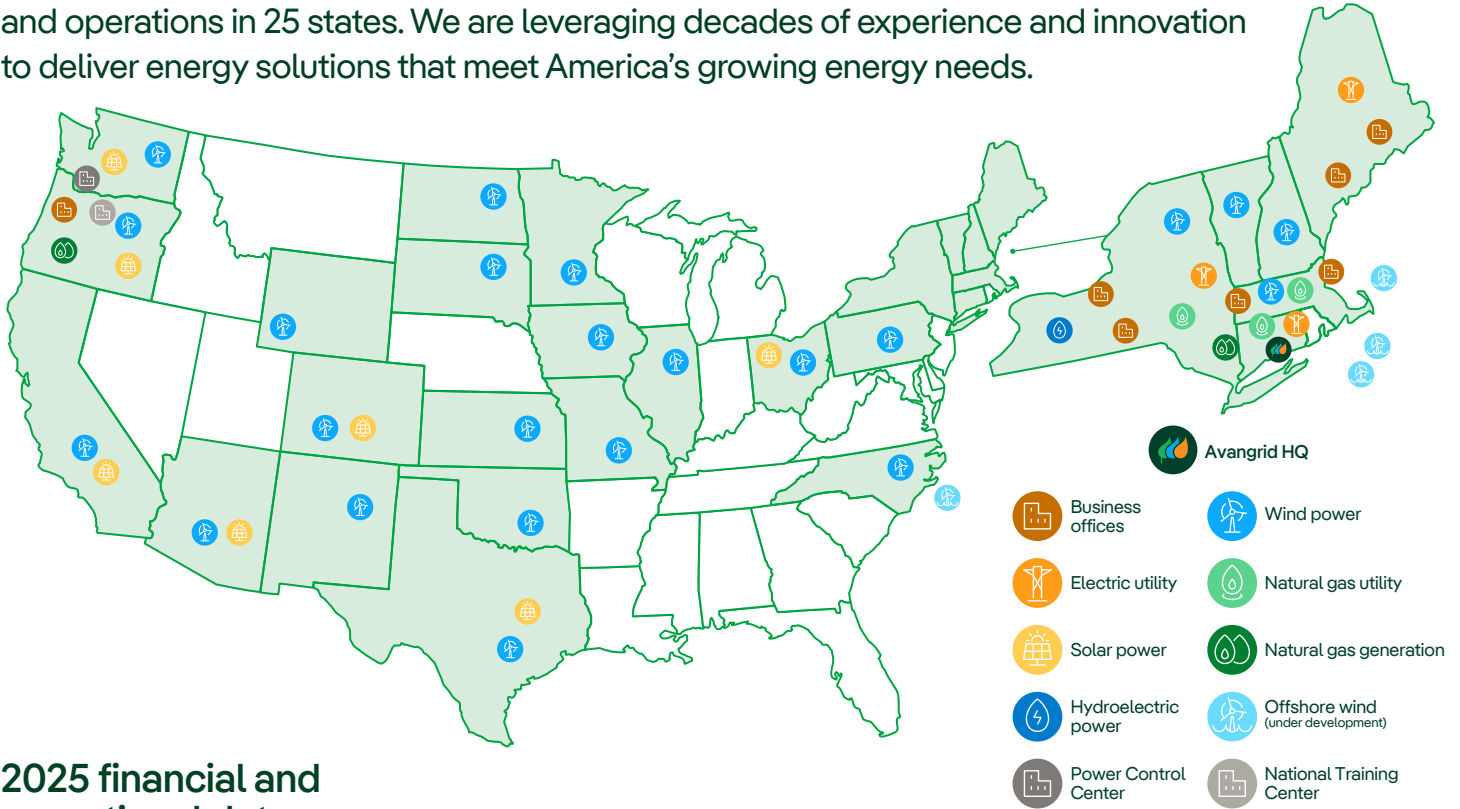
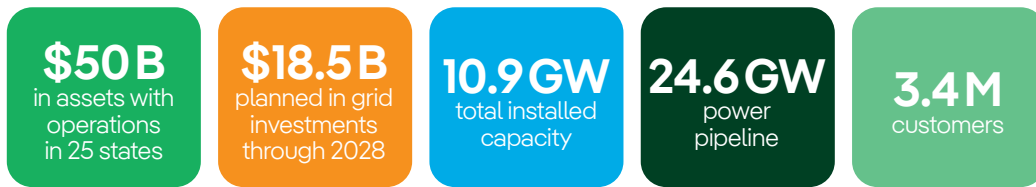

José Antonio Miranda Soto has served as Chief Executive Officer of Avangrid since June 2025. He brings more than 20 years of global leadership experience in the energy sector, with a strong track record in operational excellence, strategic growth, and innovation.

Since joining Avangrid in 2021, he has held several senior leadership roles, including President & CEO of Avangrid Power and its Onshore business, overseeing a generation portfolio of more than 10 GW. Under his leadership, Avangrid Power achieved major milestones such as bringing over 1,000 MW of new projects into commercial operation, advancing nearly 2,000 MW to final investment decisions, securing or renegotiating over 2,000 MW in power purchase agreements, and progressing landmark projects including Vineyard Wind 1, the first utility-scale offshore wind project in the United States.

Prior to Avangrid, José Antonio held senior executive roles at Siemens Gamesa across the Americas, Asia, and Latin America, and earlier leadership positions at engineering firm ABB in Spain. He has also served on the Board of Directors for the American Clean Power Association, Secretary of the Board and Executive Committee member of the American Wind Energy Association, and member of the High-Level Climate Action Panel (HICAP) for the UN Sustainable Development Goals and the International Renewable Energy Agency (IRENA).

José Antonio holds a degree in Electrical Engineering from Universidad de Oviedo and an MBA from Universidad Pontificia Comillas (ICADE).
