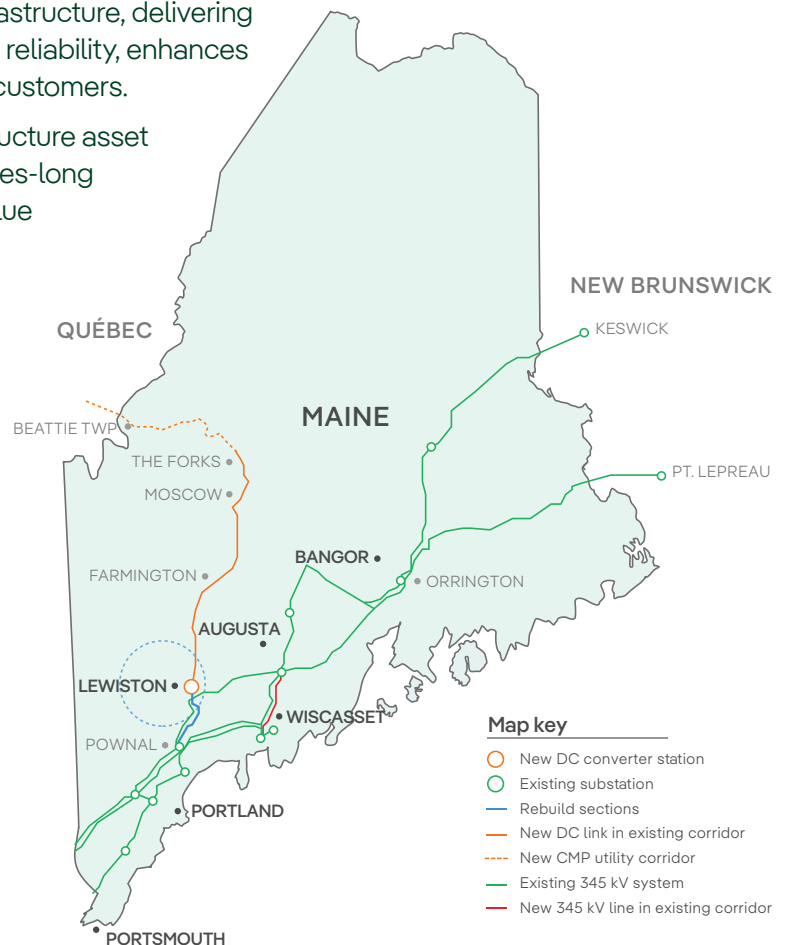


The New England Clean Energy Connect (NECEC) is a 145-mile, 1,200MW transmission line that began commercial operations in January 2026, delivering reliable hydroelectric power from Québec into the New England power grid.

NECEC is a critical piece of New England's energy infrastructure, delivering large-scale, firm baseload power that strengthens grid reliability, enhances energy security, and supports energy affordability for customers.

This project is a long-term, revenue-generating infrastructure asset with a strong financial foundation supported by decades-long contracts. The project delivers predictable, durable value and reinforces Avangrid's leadership in the sector.
