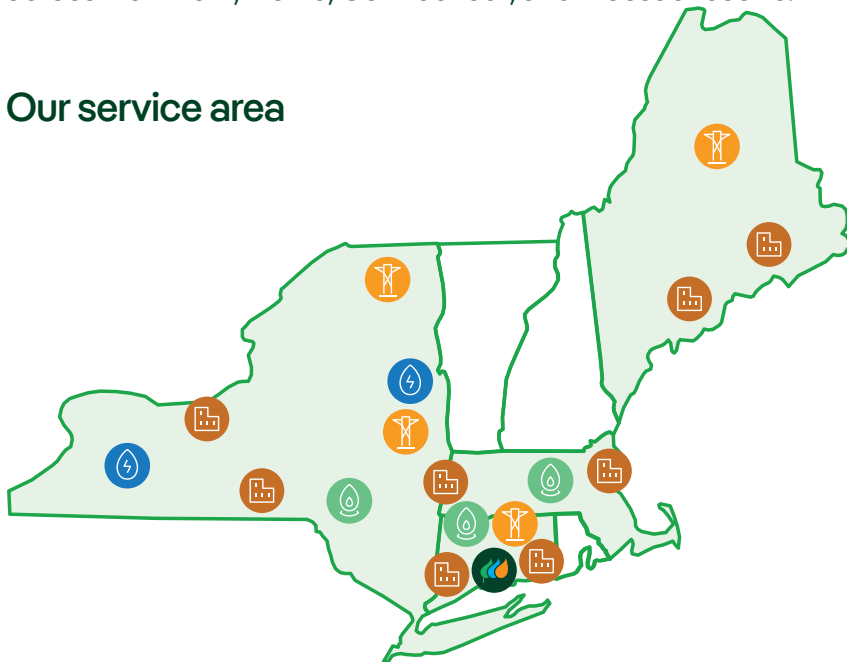

Joe Purington has served as CEO of Avangrid Networks since July 2025. Prior to this role, he was President of Central Maine Power (CMP) from September 2021. Before rejoining Avangrid, Joe served as President of Eversource New Hampshire

Operations, where he was responsible for the safe and reliable delivery of electricity to more than 500,000 customers across New Hampshire.

Earlier in his career, Joe spent 28 years at CMP in a variety of operational leadership roles, both in Maine and at Avangrid's sister companies, New York State Electric & Gas and Rochester Gas and Electric. He also served as Director of System Operations for Iberdrola USA (now Avangrid), overseeing energy control centers and substation operations to ensure compliance with all federal, regional, and state regulatory requirements. In addition, he acted as incident commander for major power restoration efforts.

Joe holds a bachelor's degree from Southern New Hampshire University and an associate degree from Southern Maine Vocational Technical Institute.
