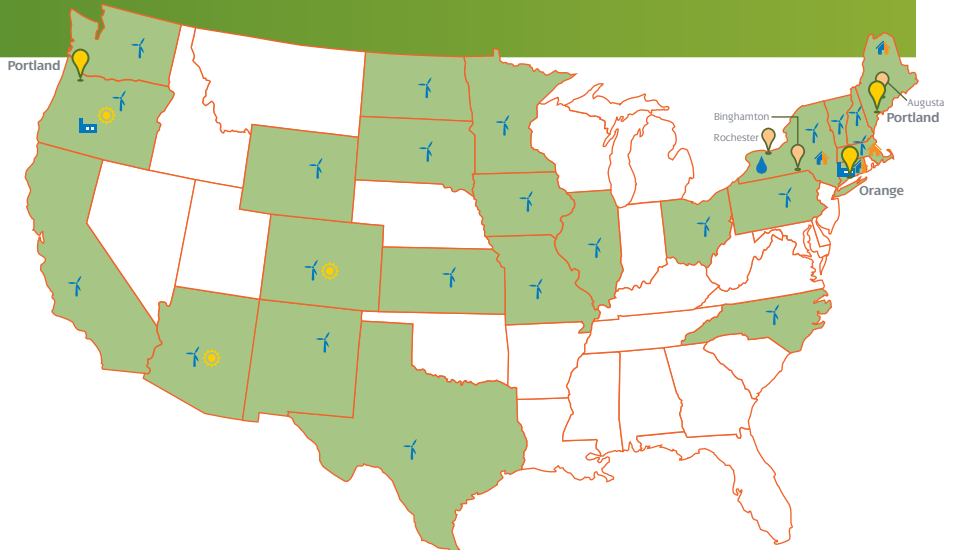

## 2017 HIGHLIGHTS

Support for basic needs like housing, fuel assistance and food reached **over 250,000** individuals and their families
